

# Head Coach Karen Hoppa

## Camp Director



Karen Hoppa just completed her eighth year as the Head Coach at Auburn University. Success has become a tradition for the Auburn Soccer program. Over the past six years, Auburn has won five SEC West titles, won the overall SEC championship in 2002, and earned five trips to the NCAA tournament. For her efforts, Hoppa was named 2002 SEC Coach of the Year. Previously, she led her University of Central Florida team to 5 conference championships, and a trip to the NCAA tournament. Coach Hoppa has 19 years of coaching experience, 22 years of playing experience, and has directed soccer camps for 12 years. She holds a USSF "A" License, was a US National Staff Coach and was an Assistant Coach for the 2002 U19 World Cup Champions. As a player, she was the 1991 NCAA Goalkeeper of the Year and an All-American.

In addition to the Auburn Soccer Coaching staff, the camp staff consists of college and high school coaches, as well as current college players. All of the staff have played soccer at a high level, which allows them to demonstrate during each session in order to aid in the learning process.

## Camp Information

### PURPOSE:

The Auburn Soccer Camp is designed to enhance the soccer player's technical and tactical knowledge by creating an environment conducive to learning. Players will develop positive habits in technical repetition, functional training, and tactical awareness. Goalkeepers will receive position-specific training. All players will be able to apply what they have learned in the evening matches.

### FACILITIES:

The Auburn Soccer Camp utilizes the state-of-the-art athletic facilities as well as the outstanding dorms and cafeteria at Auburn University located in Auburn, Alabama, just 100 miles southwest of Atlanta.

## HOW TO ENROLL:

Complete the application and mail it along with full payment or a deposit of \$100. If you wish to purchase an Auburn soccer ball, include an additional \$25 with the original payment. You may also complete the application on-line at [www.auburnsoccercamp.com](http://www.auburnsoccercamp.com). *The remainder of the balance is due 2 weeks prior to camp.*

### TEAM CAMP:

A team of 10 or more players may come to camp together and receive a \$20 per player discount. The team will train and play together in order to enhance the technical and tactical play of the team as a whole. *All team applications and deposits must be sent together in one envelope.*

### ELITE WEEKEND

High school varsity, club/select, and non-recreational soccer players this is the camp for you. The elite weekend is for serious soccer players ages 14 and up. The elite program will take you through the step by step process of what an college soccer player goes through during a weekend in a competitive season. You will receive Under Armour gear, go through the practice sessions, play games, and much more. Come spend a weekend as one of the nation's best!

### CHECK IN/CHECK OUT:

All campers will check in on Sunday, between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. and check out on Thursday, between 11:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Check-in will take place in the dorms on the hill off of Samford Rd. Specific dorms TBD.

### COMMUTERS:

Commuters will participate in the full program from registration to check out but will sleep at home rather than at the University.

### REFUNDS:

A full refund minus a \$25 processing fee will be sent only to those requesting such refund in writing at least one week prior to camp. During the week of camp, a per day pro-rated refund may be given if the camper has to leave camp early due to injury or illness.

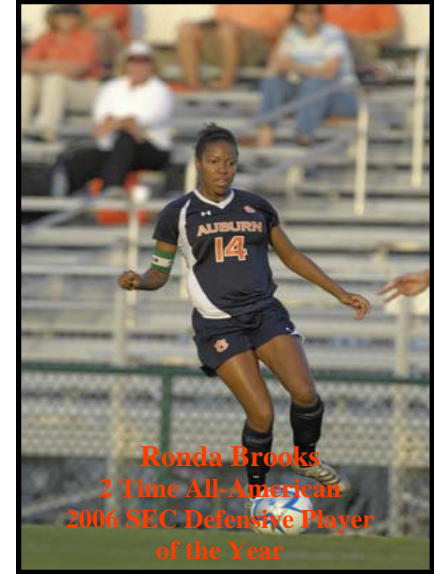
